Tips for Locating Old Immunization Records

For the safety of you and our patients and customers, we need your immunization records are required prior to your start date. If you do not have records of your immunization records, please read below:

Methodist follows the guidelines of the Center for Disease Control (CDC) for required immunizations: Please be prepared to bring documentation of the following:

Required: (either shots or blood tests)

- MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- Varicella (chicken pox)

If available, but not required:

- Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis)
- Hepatitis B
- Flu vaccine

Places you may want to check for your immunization records:

- All previous healthcare providers-doctor's office, public health departments, clinics.
- Ask your parents if they still have these records
- Any schools or colleges you attended (including high school)
- Previous employers, including the military
- State immunization registry
